ELECTIONS BYE-LAW

Subject to the appropriate paragraphs in the Constitution, the following will determine the administration of the election process for the Executive Council of the Association.

1. Balloting will be held at the place, identified by the Executive Council in advance of the election process, for at least three consecutive days prior to and including the actual day of the Annual General Meeting.
2. Ballot papers will be delivered against signature, Maltese identity card number, Club's name and membership number.
3. The election process, including the counting of votes, will be conducted by two scrutinisers appointed by the Executive Council for the purpose.
4. The following rules are to be observed for balloting:
 - a) All balloting shall be secret.
 - b) All balloting shall be by direct voting for candidates by members.
 - c) Each member may record one vote for each of the vacant positions.
 - d) All vacancies shall be balloted for concurrently.
 - e) In the event of a tie for any of the vacancies, a further ballot will be held amongst the voting members present at the meeting until one of the candidates gains a simple majority of the votes cast.
